<p>A student may only drive a private vehicle onto and/or park on school property for the purpose of attending school and must have a UAHS Student Driver Permit.</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION</p>	<p>SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
<p>Students may only drive onto school property in vehicles that are covered by third party property insurance or comprehensive insurance.</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION</p>	<p>SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
<p>Student must drive in a “safe“ manner at all times on or near the school property. They must obey all road signs and speed limits on or near the school and drive with due care.</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION and 3-6 UAHS STUDENT DERMIT POINTS POSSIBLE SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT POSSIBLE POLICE INVOLVEMENT</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period determined by the Principal) and/or POLICE INVOLVEMENT and/or SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
<p>Student may only carry passengers to and from school and only with proper school authorisation. Carrying unauthorised passengers in a students vehicle is a serious breach of the School’s Transport Policy. Unauthorized passengers have the same penalty.</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION and 3 UAHS STUDENT DERMIT POINTS and SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period no less than two weeks after the detention for the offence has been served)</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period determined by the Principal) SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>

NB: Authorisation for carrying passengers during the school day , may be granted once the required forms have been completed, received and approved by the Student Driver Coordinator.

NB : Approval to carry a 'temporary passenger' or a 'one off' trip is possible with written permission from both sets of parents and with the consent of the school.

<p>Student drivers may only leave the school in their vehicle after the last scheduled lesson of their school day. Unauthorized trips from the school are not permitted.</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION and SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT PERMIT and 3 UAHS STUDENT DERMIT POINTS (for a period no less than two weeks after the detention for the offence has been served)</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period determined by the Principal) and SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
<p>All private vehicles driven by students to school and parked on school property must:- a)Have a UAHS parking Permit clearly displayed on the windscreen of the vehicle. b)Be parked in an appropriate manner in the appropriate location for their permit.</p>	<p>LUNCHTIME DETENTION and 2 UAHS STUDENT DEMERIT POINTS</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION and 4 UAHS STUDENT DEMERIT POINTS</p>
<p>Students may not drive in unauthorised areas of the school without permission. This includes the farm/ machine shop precinct. Students must enter and leave from the gate adjacent to their assigned parking area and are not to drive 'through' the school.</p>	<p>LUNCHTIME DETENTION and 2 UAHS STUDENT DEMERIT POINTS</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION and 4 UAHS STUDENT DEMERIT POINTS</p>

<p>Year 12 student drivers ONLY may return to their vehicles throughout the day. All other students may only be in parking areas of the school when authorised. Loitering or being a nuisance in these areas is forbidden.</p>	<p>LUNCHTIME DETENTION AND TWO UAHS STUDENT DRIVER DEMERIT POINTS</p>	<p>AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION AND FOUR UAHS STUDENT DRIVER DEMERIT POINTS</p>
<p>Students must complete detentions for offences as set.</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period no less than two weeks after the detention for the offence has been served)</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
<p>Accumulating more than 5 student driver demerit points</p>	<p>SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period no less than two weeks after the detention for the offence has been served)</p>	<p>Any subsequent offence: SUSPENSION OF THE STUDENT DRIVER PERMIT (for a period determined by the Principal)</p>
